Our history

The Grade II* listed parish church of St Peter's Leckhampton with its elegant spire is a conspicuous landmark. Built in local stone by Sir John Giffard in the 14th century on the site of an even earlier 12th century chapel, it was altered and enlarged twice in the 19th century. The churchyard contains tombstones from the 17th century and an unusually rich collection of graves of 19th century Cheltonians, some of them renowned nationally.


Contrary to popular belief, the Church of England does not contribute to the upkeep of parish churches – they are deemed the property of the parish and responsibility for their upkeep lies solely with the local Parochial Church Council. The annual upkeep of the St Peter's church building and churchyard costs nearly £20,000 (churchyard maintenance £10,400; general church maintenance £3,500; insurance £5,600).











The Friends

The Friends of St Peter's Leckhampton scheme exists solely to maintain the fabric of the church building and the churchyard. The ongoing work of worship, mission and ministry of the church is supported through offertory collections and a separate Parish Giving Scheme.
