Dear Customer,

A417 Missing Link – Weekend closures

Kier Transportation is working on behalf of National Highways to deliver the A417 Missing Link. We're writing to inform you that as part of this work, there will be weekend closures on the A417 which may disrupt your journeys.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The A417 will be closed between the A46 Brockworth junction and the Air Balloon roundabout for two full weekends between the following dates:

- 11pm on Friday 21 February to 6am on Monday 24 February
- 11pm on Friday 7 March to 6am on Monday 10 March

We will be working at this location to install drainage and utilities. This will require full weekend closures, with work continuing day and night to remove the closure as quickly as possible.

We have taken measures to reduce disruption where possible. Thank you for your patience and understanding during this time.

Fully signposted diversion routes will be in place during the closure. Please follow the official diversion route and not satnavs:

Southbound diversion - Brockworth Junction to Air Balloon roundabout:

1. Turn left towards Cheltenham onto the A46 Shurdington Road
2. Turn right towards Oxford onto the A40 Thirlestaine Road
3. Turn right towards Cirencester onto the A40 Old bath Road
4. Turn right towards Cirencester on the A345
5. Continue straight towards Birdlip
6. Turn right on the Seven Springs roundabout onto the A436
7. Turn left towards Cirencester onto the A417

Northbound diversion - Air Balloon roundabout to Brockworth junction:

1. From Seven Springs roundabout, follow Cirencester road towards Cheltenham
2. Continue on the A435 and turn left towards Cheltenham onto the A40
3. Turn left onto the A40 Old Bath Road
4. Follow the road to the right and remain on the A40
5. Turn left onto the A46 Shurdington Road
6. Take the third turning at Brockworth junction to travel towards Gloucester

Access for residents with permits and emergency services will be fully maintained during the closures.
