



This star knitting pattern is worked flat.

Use size 9 or 10 needles (metric: 3.75mm or 3.5mm) with double knitting wool.

Instructions

Abbreviations: Knit (k); Pearl (p); Knit 3 together (k3tog); repeat (rep); stitches (sts)

Cast on 117 stitches.

1. Knit one row.
2. Right side (RS) K11, *k3tog, k20; rep from * to the last 14 sts, k3tog, k11. [107 sts]
3. Wrong side (WS) K10, *p3tog, k18; rep from * to last 13 sts, p3tog, k10. [97 sts]
4. K9, *k3tog, k16; rep from * to last 12 sts, k3tog, k9. [87 sts]
5. K8, *p3tog, k14; rep from * to last 11 sts, p3tog, k8. [77 sts]
6. K7, *k3tog, k12; rep from * to last 10 sts, k3tog, k7. [67 sts]
7. K6, *p3tog, k10; rep from * to last 9 sts, p3tog, k6. [57 sts]
8. K5, *k3tog, k8; rep from * to last 8 sts, k3tog, k5. [47 sts]
9. K4, *p3tog, k6; rep from * to last 7 sts, p3tog, k4. [37 sts]
10. K3, *k3tog, k4; rep from * to last 6 sts, k3tog, k3. [27 sts]
11. K2, *p3tog, k2; rep from * to last 5 sts, p3tog, k2. [17 sts]
12. K1, k3tog 5 times, k1. [7 sts]

Note: the stitch produced by 'k3tog' becomes the middle stitch of the next 'p3tog'. A stitch marker might help.

Break yarn and thread through remaining sts. Sew together short edges with right sides together (it will make sense when you get to this point!). Weave in ends. Iron flat if necessary. Attach hanging loop.
